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7. BACKGROUND

The FRDC recognises that digital media (websites and social networking) play an essential role in enabling the FRDC to fulfil its mission and achieve its goals. It is seen as a critical tool for the facilitation, dissemination and extension of FRDC content.

The FRDC actively supports and encourages the use of its websites to promote the FRDC's purpose and its research, development and extension activities.

8. POLICY

The FRDC will ensure that its websites':

- are accessible for all users, including users with limited access (i.e. remote locations) and people with disabilities (i.e. visually impaired) and wherever possible comply with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) version 2
- contents are evidence based, reliable, accurate, current, and applicable
- provide information and services that are relevant to stakeholders
- minimise management, maintenance, and duplication of content
- have a feedback mechanism in place to enable timely response to both feedback and complaints
- provide readily available access to current and historical knowledge generated from FRDC research, development and extension investment activities (e.g. final reports)
- will be subject to periodic evaluation to ensure they are fit for purpose
- comply with relevant Commonwealth legislation and policies – including but not limited to privacy, accessibility and records management
